Message from the Teachers

Please make sure you are bringing in your child's snow gear every week as we will be going outside on the nicer winter days.

Hats, gloves, snow pants, snow boots, heavy coat. Please also make sure they are labeled and in a labeled bag!

Sick Policy:

Fever of 99.9 or higher they cannot return to daycare until they are fever free without the use of Tylenol.

Diarrhea – 2 or more stools in 24 hours. Child cannot return until stool is normal for 48 hours.

Vomiting – child cannot return until it has been 48 hours after the last time they vomited.

Cough – if your child has a bad cough that is NOT under control, they cannot return to daycare until it is under control.

Pink Eye – must be on drops for 48 hours before returning to daycare.

Croup – must be on a steroid for 48 hours before returning.

Strep- child may not return for 48 hours after starting antibiotic.

COVID 19 POLICY

The Department of Health and Honey Bee ask that you please do the following before bringing your child to daycare:

1. Take your child's temp – if 99.9 or higher, please keep them home!
2. If your child is saying they do not feel well (tummy hurts, head hurts, throat hurts, overly tired) please keep them home as it is the time of year for flu, influenza, rsv, and other illnesses.
3. If one child is sick, please keep all other children home.

We understand that having to keep all children home can be draining and frustrating especially if you have one child sick, but we are looking out for the best interest of the kids and staff. We appreciate more than you know, all the cooperation!!

CDC / HONEY BEE QUARENTINE GUIDELINES:

7 Days

- Quarantine THROUGH day 7 since last date of exposure.
- Negative result by molecular or antigen test (specimen collected on day 5 or later) and then release from quarantine day 7.
- Person must remain asymptomatic prior to release and continue to monitor through day 14.
- If a person has not received a negative test result by day 7, the person must remain in quarantine until their negative test result is received.

10 Days

- Quarantine through day 10 since date of last exposure.
- No test needed.
- Person must remain asymptomatic prior to release and continue to monitor through day 14.
